



“DRESS FOR SUCCESS” AT BAYSHORE ELEMENTARY: 2016/2017

Shirts: Must be correctly sized, in good shape, and must be solid in color.

- ✓ All shirts must have a collar (golf, turtle neck, or Oxford style).
- ✓ All shirts must have sleeves.
- ✓ All shirts must be tucked in at the waist.
- ✓ Bayshore “spirit” or school sponsored t-shirts may be worn on Fridays’ or the last day of the school week.
- ✓ Shirts can have a small embellishment no larger than a quarter (manufacturer’s emblems).

Pants: Must be solid in color, correctly sized, and in good shape.

- ✓ Solid color pants, shorts, skirts, and jumpers (must be past fingertip length).
- ✓ No athletic shorts, spandex, tight fitting apparel, or sweat suits.
- ✓ Jeans are permitted.
- ✓ Embellished and/or torn jeans are not acceptable.
- ✓ All pants must be worn at the waist.
- ✓ Belts must be worn if there are belt loops.
- ✓ Kindergarten students are encouraged to wear pants with elastic waistbands.
- ✓ Camouflage and plaid are not acceptable.

Shorts/skirts/dresses: Must be solid in color, correctly sized, and in good repair.

- ✓ All shorts must be past fingertip length.
- ✓ All skirts/dresses must be no shorter than just above knee and must be worn with solid colored leggings or shorts underneath.
- ✓ All shorts/skirts must be worn at the waist. Belts must be worn if there are belt loops.
- ✓ Camouflage and Plaid are not acceptable.

Shoes/Boots: Must be safe, correctly sized, and in good repair.

- ✓ Shoes/boots must have closed toes and closed heels.
- ✓ If shoes have shoelaces, the laces must be properly laced and tied.
- ✓ Shoes with only a heel strap are not permitted.
- ✓ All shoes and boots with heels must be less than one inch high.
- ✓ No shoes with wheels may be worn on school grounds.

Accessories: Students are strongly discouraged from wearing jewelry to school.

- ✓ Body piercing (with the exception of earrings), unnatural hair colors, temporary tattoos, hats, sunglasses, makeup, and fake fingernails may cause disruption to our learning environment. If they cause a disruption, school personnel may ask students to remove items. Parents will be responsible to pick up confiscated items.
- ✓ Any jewelry worn to school will not be the responsibility of the school.
- ✓ Cell phones are permitted in school but must be turned off and kept in a safe place during school hours. The school is not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen cell phones.

Backpacks: Parents are requested to select a backpack for their child that is an appropriate size.

Outer Garments: Unless outer garments such as jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters conform to the dress code as outlined above, they are not to be worn inside the school building or hybrids. Jackets may not be worn around the waist or as a cover for blouses and shirts not in dress code. Outer garments must be correctly sized and worn appropriately. **No hooded garments allowed.**

Dress Code Closet: A closet containing items in conformity with the dress code will be housed in the office. Students not in code may wear items from the store for the day if parents can’t bring appropriate clothing to school. Donations are accepted.

Compliance with school dress code is required. Non-compliance after being warned by the teacher will result in a discipline referral (see Level 1, D1 in the Code of Student Conduct). Continued non-compliance will be considered a Level 2 offense, D2, defiance of authority/school policy.
