Shorts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid black, khaki, or navy plain uniform type shorts • Must be worn with a belt if belt loops are present • Must be past fingertip length 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jeans, Denim • Cut-offs, frayed, ripped, rolled up or patched • Cargo shorts/any type of hammer loops • Shorts shorter than fingertip length • Fad, no embellishments, writing, embroidery, or jeweled designs on any part of the shorts
Pants: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid black, khaki, or navy plain uniform type pants • Must be worn with a belt if belt loops are present 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Leggings or jeggings • Fad, embellishments, writing, embroidery, or jeweled designs on any part of the pants
Dresses & Skirts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid black, khaki, or navy • Plain, uniform style • Must be past fingertip length 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No denim/jeans dresses or skirts • Sleeveless or strapless • Dresses, skorts, skirts shorter than fingertip length • Fad, embellishments, writing, embroidery, or jeweled designs on any part of the dress/skirt
Shirts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid color collared shirts – Any color • Must have sleeves • Tucking is preferred, it is required for long shirts that that are past the wrist. • Plain, logo no larger than 1 inch 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Striped or plaid shirts • Tank tops, sleeveless or strapless • Fad, embellishments, writing, embroidery, or jeweled designs on any part of the shirt
Belts: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid colored leather or solid colored cloth belts • Plain 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sparkles, jewels, embellishments, or stripes • Large or designed belt buckles
Shoes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closed-toed shoes with a solid back or back strap • Traditional sneakers with matching laces 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shoes with lights, music or wheels • Sandals, heels, flip-flops, or cleats
Jackets: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blazers or sweaters • Plain, solid colored • Any color or print zip-up/pullover sweatshirt 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sweatshirts/jackets with any depictions of inappropriate language or graphics • Camouflage
Hair: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Well groomed, out of face, non-distracting • Non-distracting hair color 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sweatbands, hats, hoods, & picks
Accessories: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jewelry and nails must be non-distracting 	NO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visible facial/body piercings • Excessive jewelry • Tattoos (writing on skin)
