CAST offers band class to students enrolled in grades 5-8. Band classes are classified into beginning, intermediate, and advanced.  - Uniforms will be provided by CAST with minor cleaning fees
 - Ladies: Black Dresses
 - o Gentlemen: Tuxedo Uniform Blank pants/Black Shoes (opt for ladies)

Rehearsal and Performance Expectations:

- After School rehearsals
- In school and after school performances at CAST throughout the year
- Four County Honor Band and All County Honor
 - Based on director's recommendation
- Solo and Ensemble is required for all returning band member
 - o Optional for first year members (but highly recommended)
 - Based on the performance costs may occur for a piano accompanist
