SeaWorld

May 31st, 2017 is our scheduled field trip to SeaWorld. We are asking that **ALL** students/chaperones (riding the bus) arrive at Fairlawn **no later than 6:45 AM**. Our parking is limited so we are asking chaperones to park in the WEST parking lot. Please make sure that everyone has eaten breakfast **BEFORE** arriving in the morning. Once we check in at SeaWorld, every student will be provided with a single meal voucher for lunch (only chaperones that have purchased a meal voucher will be provided with one). It is **HIGHLY** suggested that students not bring any electronics on the bus. SeaWorld does not allow students to carry bags into the park, therefore whatever they bring will remain on the bus. Teachers will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items. This is still a scheduled school day, therefore the Code of Conduct, including rules pertaining to cellphone use, will be in effect!! The students are being asked to wear their 5th Grade Graduation T-shirt, comfortable, school-appropriate length shorts, and closed-toed shoes. The buses are scheduled to return to Fairlawn at 6:00 PM. Please **DO NOT** park in the car pick-up loop, this is the area the buses will use to load and unload students. Bus
