

## ACCEPTABLE DRESS CODE FOR STUDENTS

### All students may wear:

- ✓ Collared shirts with sleeves, tucked-in and not see-through.
- ✓ Button down Collared shirts must be tucked-in and buttoned up above the chest.
- ✓ Collared shirts with necklines that do not reveal cleavage and must have sleeves.
- ✓ Multiple shirts must all be tucked in.
- ✓ Belts worn in pant/skirt loops at all times. Belts are required if pants have loops and they must be visible.
- ✓ Pants worn above hip-bone at the waist, no sagging.
- ✓ All dresses must be collared and knee length.
- ✓ Dresses/shorts/skirts or skirt slits at knee length.
- ✓ Clothing that does not reveal underwear.
- ✓ Dress shoes, tennis shoes, boots or sandals. Shoes must be tied at all times.
- ✓ Jackets, sweatshirts with a hood or sweaters (no obscene graphics).

### All students may ***NOT*** wear: (Additional Clarification)

- ❖ Shirts and pants that are frayed, torn, cut or include chains.
- ❖ HEAD PHONES/WIRES for phones and electronic devices may not be visible as part of a student's outfit. And is considered a violation of the School Board electronic device policy. (see code of conduct section on electronic devices)
- ❖ Students are not permitted to wear any dress style, grooming or appearance that reflects membership in any group which advocates drug use, violence, suicide, or gang affiliation.
- ❖ Clothing (including hats) or jewelry which promotes the use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, racism, violence, intolerance or that is sexually suggestive may not be worn.
- ❖ Sunglasses and head coverings may not be worn. These items are subject to confiscation and will be held for parental pickup. THE SCHOOL AND ITS STAFF ASSUME NO LIABILITY OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY CONFISCATED ITEM.
- ❖ Biking, "soffee", running shorts, nylon athletic shorts. (No elastic waistband pants)
- ❖ Leggings under a skirt or dress and/or jeggings (jean leggings)
- ❖ Jogging suits or sweat pants.
- ❖ Slippers or beach shoes (no athletic slippers/flip flops)
- ❖ Modified/altered shirts or clothes. (Ex: rubber bands, cuts, paints, pictures)
- ❖ Thermal Shirts

### SPIRIT FRIDAYS

#### The following items can be worn:

- School sponsored t-shirts
- School sponsored scrubs for medical students
- No solid color T-shirts are permitted without the school logo.

### PROFESSIONAL DRESS DAYS

Teachers may designate certain days for Professional Dress. The Professional Dress must adhere to school dress code standards, with exception to scrubs worn by Medical students.

### CONSEQUENCES FOR DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS

*If the violation cannot be fixed the student will have to complete work in the Behavior Intervention Classroom (BIC).*

- ✓ **First Offense:** Student receives a written warning and is asked to call home to fix the problem with his/her attire.
- ✓ **Second Offense:** Student calls home to fix the problem with his/her attire, receives a discipline referral and after school detention.
- ✓ **Third Offense:** Student receives Behavior Intervention Class (BIC) with increasing consequences after that.
