# **Mariposa- Dress Code for Students:**

#### Personal Appearance and Accessories

<u>Belts:</u> Must be worn if belt loops are part of the article of clothing. No oversized belt buckles.

<u>Jewelry:</u> Earrings must be no larger than quarter size. Neck Chains/Necklaces allowed if discreet. No jewelry is permitted if it detracts from learning.

<u>Hair</u>: Hair must be clean and neat. No unnatural colors, no Mohawks, no designs cut into the hair. Hair cannot be a distraction from learning.

<u>Head attire:</u> No head attire allowed with the exception of culturally mandated head attire.

<u>Sunglasses:</u> With Doctor's prescription on file.

Shirts/Blouses

Type allowed: Collared shirt/blouse with sleeves in any color or pattern (no camouflage) and **must be tucked in**. Appropriate logos of pocket size are allowed.

- Monday Friday: Mariposa Elementary T-shirts shirts may be worn.
- Wednesdays: College shirt day (wear your favorite college T-Shirt).

#### Jeans/Pants/Shorts/Skirts/Leggings

Type allowed: Logos may be present if discreet. In any color or pattern. No camouflage and no rips or tears. No leggings unless covered by long shorts/skirt. Jeans/Pants/Shorts/Skirts \*\* must meet fingertip test for length) \*\*\* No athletic shorts or sweat suits allowed K-5.

## **Dresses/Jumpers**

Allowed: Logos may be present if discreet. In any color or pattern. Must have sleeves and pass the fingertip test.

## Shoes/Sneakers (no sandals, boots or flips flops)

Allowed: Shoes/sneakers must have closed toes with a back on them.

## Outerwear: Sweatshirts/Jackets/Sweaters (NO Hoodies)

Allowed: Appropriate logos may be present if discreet. In any color or pattern. (No camouflage or large designs.) If clothing item has a hood, it may be worn ONLY to and from school.

Students and parents should be warned when students are out of dress code.

# **Dress Code Violation Consequences:**

#### Dress Code Violation Form located in APPENDIX.

1st Offense: Student warning. Teacher will contact parents to bring a

change of clothes and the student may return to class when

appropriately dressed.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: Lunch detention. Teacher will contact parents to bring a

change of clothes.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: School Service. (Administration will contact parent.)

4<sup>th</sup> Offense: In-School Suspension (Administration will contact parent.)

After 4th: Open defiance of school policy. Out of school suspension with

required parent conference.
