



# Oak Hammock K-8 School: 2016-2017 Dress Code

**The school administration and teachers will continue to expect all students to dress in a fashion that reflects good taste and a style appropriate for school.**

<b>Shirts</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Solid or Striped polo-style or button down shirt (<i>logos must be pocketsized</i>)</li> <li>Shirt tucked in at all times</li> <li>Only the two top buttons can be unbuttoned</li> <li>Oak Hammock K-8 School Spirit shirts</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Non-school t-shirts, PE uniform shirts, sleeveless or backless shirts</li> <li>Sheer or see-through material</li> <li>Shirts that are untucked, unbuttoned, or reveal undergarments</li> <li>Logos larger than pocketsized</li> </ul>
<b>Pants</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Solid colored (except white) pants, shorts, or skorts</li> <li>Solid denim/jeans without any graphics/embellishments or frayed, cut, damaged/destroyed</li> <li>Worn securely at the waist</li> <li>Shorts/skorts must come to the knee</li> <li>A belt must be worn with pants/shorts/skorts that have belt loops (<i>Kindergarten &amp; 1<sup>st</sup> grade students are exempt from belt requirement</i>)</li> <li>Solid colored uniform jumpers for grades K-3 (<i>worn with shorts</i>)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ripped, torn, or shredded pants/shorts</li> <li>Jeggings or any stretchy material</li> <li>Skirts or dresses</li> <li>Joggers</li> <li>Jogging/sweat pants or gym shorts (<i>outside of PE class</i>)</li> <li>Belts with spikes or studs, or buckles larger than 2" x 2"</li> <li>Camouflage, patterned and/or white pants, shorts, or jeans</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Shoes with closed toe and back</li> <li>Heels must be smaller than 1"</li> <li>All straps and laces properly fastened</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Slides, flip-flops, sandals, or slippers</li> <li>Shoes with wheels</li> </ul>
<b>Jackets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Solid color sweatshirts, jackets or sweaters</li> <li>Pocketsized logos</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hoods may not be worn on the head except outside in cold weather</li> <li>Logos larger than pocketsize</li> </ul>
<b>Other</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hair neatly done in natural colors</li> <li>Jewelry: pierced ears are permitted; earrings no larger than 2"</li> <li>Plain or charm style necklaces</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any tight fitting apparel</li> <li>Clothing displaying vulgar writing/pictures or references to sex, alcohol, or tobacco</li> <li>Hats/Caps and Sunglasses</li> <li>Sweatbands or any hair grooming aids</li> <li>Outrageous hair color dyes (<i>blue, pink, etc.</i>)</li> <li>Tongue, nose, or other visible body piercing</li> <li>Tag rags, bandanas, or other gang related apparel or items</li> <li>Earbuds and headphones</li> <li>Heavy chains (safety issues)</li> <li>Blankets</li> </ul>

**Administration/designees shall be the final judge of dress code.**

They have the authority to determine if the apparel is distracting, disruptive, or the cause of harm to the educational process.

If a student comes to school wearing clothing that is not part of the approved Oak Hammock dress code, he/she will be removed from class and sent to the Deans' Office. Once there, we will notify parents. **If a parent is unable to bring appropriate clothing for the student to wear, the student will remain out of class for the duration of the day.** Certain unapproved items (such as non-compliant jackets, earbuds, hats, etc.) will be confiscated and returned to a parent.

**Fixable Dress Code Violations** (i.e. untucked shirts) will be handled in the following manner:

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense – Parent Contact – phone call from teacher
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense – 2<sup>nd</sup> Parent Contact – letter/phone call from Dean's Clerk
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense – Parent phone call by Dean, lunch detention
- Subsequent offenses may result in afterschool detention or in/out of school suspension from school.
