SLW Centennial Parking Permit Application

Fill out this form, and submit it to the School of Arts & Communications office in Q118. Student driver AND parent/guardian signatures are **REQUIRED** for processing. **Parking applications will not be accepted without a copy of student driver license and a copy of proof of insurance and a \$25 fee in cash. Checks or other forms of payments other than cash will not be accepted.**

Students are allowed to park in the student parking lot from 7:00 AM until 1:45 PM. Students that are OFF CAMPUS Dual Enrollment and/or Abbreviated Schedule will be assigned to park in the McChesney Lot that is located directly south across the road from the school. Dual Enrollment and abbreviated schedule students will be required to arrive and depart through the main office area signing in and out.

School assigned parking is a PRIVILEGE, not a right. Parking permits may be revoked if students do not abide by all local and state motor vehicle laws. Students are expected to adhere to the rules in the Centennial Student Handbook. Violation of such said rules may result in parking privileges being revoked. District attendance policies must be adhered to in order to maintain the parking permit. **Consequently, students must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA to keep the parking privilege. In addition, excessive unexcused tardies and absences will result in loss of parking privileges for the remainder of the year.**

Students parking in unauthorized areas may have their vehicle towed at the owners expense, and will lose their parking privileges for the remainder of the school year. Students and parents acknowledge that parking is at their own risk. The School and School Board are not responsible for any damages to vehicles or to the vehicle's contents. Students are not to "hang out" in the parking lots. Students MUST have administrative permission to return to their car or to the parking lots during the school day. The student parking lots are school board property, and **ALL** school rules/policies apply.
