



## TREASURE COAST HIGH SCHOOL

**Student Dress Code Standards:** It is the desire and intent of Treasure Coast High School to adopt a dress code that creates an environment conducive to learning and free of potential danger. Students are to observe the following guidelines at all times during school hours and at school activities.

School administration/designee shall be the final judge of apparel and accessories. Administration/designees will determine whether apparel is appropriate, disruptive, offensive, distracting, or in violation of health and safety rules.

**All students must be covered from shoulders to knees. This includes, but is not limited to, pants that are frayed or torn.**

**All students must not wear:**

- ◆ Hats, visors, bandanas, hoods on head, or sunglasses
- ◆ Biking or “Soffee” shorts, running shorts, leggings, jeggings or yoga pants
- ◆ Shorts or pants with writing on the backside
- ◆ Backless shoes or slippers
- ◆ Jewelry considered unsafe (brass knuckle type rings, studded belts, chains on pants, etc.)
- ◆ Sheer (see-through) fabrics
- ◆ Undergarments must not be visible or outlined (through both loose or form-fitted clothing)
- ◆ Sleeveless shirts, shirts that expose the midriff or cleavage, or shirts with cutouts
- ◆ Clothing that is offensive and promotes violence, alcohol, tobacco, drugs or has the potential to compromise campus safety
- ◆ Earbuds or headphones
