

During the month of September, we will be finishing up our place value unit and moving on to multiplication! Remember to practice your fact fluency. Xtramath.org or flash cards are some fun ways to practice fluency. In reading, we are working on using text evidence to find your answer and identifying the main idea of an informational text.

This is going to be a F"A"NTASTIC year in third grade!

4th grade

4th grade is off to a busy start this year! Students are learning how to be more prepared as they adjust to having multiple teachers and more rigorous curriculum to learn. In math, students are working on place value. In writing, they are learning the beginning steps of formulating sufficient paragraphs and in Reading they are learning how to use text and graphic features to help understand the text better. Science has been all about learning the scientific method and basic concepts. Students have been busy learning so many new things already this year in fourth grade while socially distancing as much as possible. It is sure to be a rocking year!!

5th grade

The 5th grade teachers welcome you to a new school year! We look forward to a wonderful year of fun and learning. The first couple weeks will be spent establishing procedures and norms for both traditional and virtual students and reviewing standards from the last quarter of 4th grade. Students will also be taking a math and reading diagnostic to help us in planning our lessons. We want to ensure we are reaching each student's individual needs and helping them reach their full potential this year. Our main goals are making sure everyone is safe and middle school ready!  - Meal orders can be placed Thursday through Saturday
 - Select child on the family access account
 - Request meal date: click drop down
 - Enter Email address
 - Pick up location: click drop down and select pick up location
 - Repeat steps for additional students
- 3 PICKUP MEALS**
 - Meal orders are picked up every Wednesday
 - Pick up meals at selected location
 - Meals can only be picked up at location times
 - Meals can only be picked up through drive through
