



“DRESS FOR SUCCESS” AT BAYSHORE ELEMENTARY: 2018/2019

Shirts: Must be correctly sized and in good shape (shirts may be any color solids, stripes, or plaid – No wording on shirts is permitted)

- ✓ All shirts must have a collar.
- ✓ All shirts must have sleeves.
- ✓ Shirts may not hang below the inseam of bottoms.
- ✓ Bayshore “spirit” or school sponsored t-shirts may be worn any day of the week with dress code approved bottoms.
- ✓ Shirts can have a small manufacturer’s emblem no larger than a fist.
- ✓ Camouflage is NOT acceptable.

Pants/bottoms: Must be correctly sized and in good shape. (pants may be any color solids, stripes, or plaid)

- ✓ All pants, shorts, skirts, and jumpers must be past fingertip length.
- ✓ No athletic shorts, leggings, spandex, tight fitting apparel, or sweat suits (this includes joggers in sweat suit material)
- ✓ Jeans are permitted.
- ✓ Embellished and/or torn jeans are not acceptable.
- ✓ All pants must be worn at the waist. Belts are only required if pants are sagging.
- ✓ Kindergarten students are encouraged to wear pants with elastic waistbands.
- ✓ Camouflage is NOT acceptable.

Shorts/skirts/dresses: Must be correctly sized and in good repair. (bottoms may be any color solids, stripes, or plaid)

- ✓ All shorts must be past fingertip length.
- ✓ All skirts/dresses must be no shorter than just above knee and must be worn with **solid colored** leggings or shorts underneath. (solid colored leggings are **ONLY** permitted with skirts/dresses)
- ✓ All shorts/skirts must be worn at the waist.

Shoes/Boots: Must be safe, correctly sized, and in good repair.

- ✓ Shoes/boots must have closed toes and closed heels.
- ✓ If shoes have shoelaces, the laces must be properly laced and tied.
- ✓ All shoes and boots with heels must be less than one inch high.
- ✓ No shoes with wheels may be worn on school grounds.

Accessories: Students are strongly discouraged from wearing jewelry to school.

- ✓ Body piercing (with the exception of earrings), unnatural hair colors, temporary tattoos, hats, sunglasses, makeup, and fake fingernails may cause disruption to our learning environment. If they cause a disruption, school personnel may ask students to remove items. Parents will be responsible to pick up confiscated items.
- ✓ Any jewelry worn to school will not be the responsibility of the school.
- ✓ Cell phones are permitted in school but must be turned off and out of sight. The school is **NOT** responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen cell phones.

Backpacks: Parents are requested to select a backpack for their child that is an appropriate size.

Outer Garments: Unless outer garments such as jackets, sweatshirts, and sweaters conform to the dress code as outlined above, they are not to be worn inside the school building or hybrids. Jackets may not be worn around the waist or as a cover for blouses and shirts not in dress code. Outer garments must be correctly sized and worn appropriately. Hoods must remain off the head while inside of the building.

Compliance with school dress code is required. Non-compliance after being warned by the teacher will result in a discipline referral (see Level 1, D1 in the Code of Student Conduct). Continued non-compliance will be considered a Level 2 offense, D2, defiance of authority/school policy.
