IMPORTANT TESTING POLICIES

ELECTRONIC DEVICES POLICY—IF STUDENTS ARE FOUND WITH ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, CELL PHONES OR SMARTPHONES, DURING TESTING OR DURING BREAKS, THEIR TESTS WILL BE INVALIDATED. THE BEST PRACTICE WOULD BE FOR STUDENTS TO LEAVE DEVICES AT HOME OR IN THEIR LOCKERS ON THE DAY OF TESTING.

LEAVING CAMPUS—IF STUDENTS LEAVE CAMPUS BEFORE COMPLETING A TEST SESSION (FOR LUNCH, AN APPOINTMENT, ILLNESS, ETC.), THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RETURN TO THAT SESSION. STUDENTS AND PARENTS/GUARDIANS SHOULD BE AWARE OF THIS POLICY. IF A STUDENT DOES NOT FEEL WELL ON THE DAY OF TESTING, IT MAY BE BEST FOR THE STUDENT TO WAIT AND BE TESTED ON A MAKE-UP DAY.





IMPORTANT TESTING POLICIES

Discussing Test Content after Testing—The last portion of the testing rules read to students before they affirm the Testing Rules Acknowledgment reads, “Because the content of all statewide assessments is secure, you may not discuss or reveal details about the test items or passages after the test. This includes any type of electronic communication, such as texting, emailing, or posting online, for example, on websites like Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram.”

While students may not share information about secure test content after testing, this policy is not intended to prevent students from discussing their testing experiences with their parents/families

IMPACT

- Student performance impacts instructional decisions and student placement for next year.
- Students in grade 3 must achieve a Level 2 or higher on the FSA ELA Reading Assessment for promotion purposes
- Alternative promotion criteria include: SAT 10, Unit Assessments, iReady or Summer School
- Middle Schools use FSA scores to determine class schedules.
