DRESS CODE POLICIES

- Tops/shirts must meet or cover the waistband of bottom attire when standing or sitting normally.
- No midriff skin or undergarment shall be visible.
- Necklines for tops must not be lower than the "line" across the underarms.
- Skirts and shorts should be no shorter than your fingertip when arms are extended downward to the sides.
- Shirts or tops must have sleeves.



DRESS CODE VIOLATION CONSEQUENCES

1ST

- BIC (Behavioral Intervention Class) until fixed.
- Level 1 Referral (D1 - Dress Code).

2ND

- BIC until fixed.
- Level 1 Referral (D1 - Dress Code)
- 60- minutes after school detention.

3RD

- BIC until fixed.
- Level 1 Referral (D1 - Dress Code)
- 120- minutes after school detention.

4TH

- BIC for the remainder of the day.
- Level 2 Referral (D2 - Open Defiance).
- 2- days of 120 minutes after school detention.
- Mandatory Parent Conference.



SCHOOL ID

- School ID badges are to be worn around the neck on a school issued lanyard.
 - School ID badges is the only item allowed on the lanyard.
 - School ID badges must always be visible and may not be altered, modified, or covered in any way.
- (Replacement IDs have a \$5 dollar charge)

NOT ALLOWED

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE PROHIBITED:



Any clothing that is tight fitting, see-through, and/or fishnet material.



Any head coverings unless for a religious or medical reason.



Any blankets or flags used as a covering.



Any item referring to alcohol, drug or weapons or anything profane, obscene, or indicating gang or criminal association.



Spiked jewelry, chains that hang below the pants pockets, or beaded rave bracelets.



Bandanas, doo-rags, or hair nets of any kind are not permitted on campus or at any school event.



Any clothing with holes, rips, frays or tears above the knee.



TECHNOLOGY



• Use of cell phones or electronic devices and headphones/headsets/earbuds **MUST** be set on silent mode and in a backpack during instructional time.



• External audio speakers are **NOT** permitted on campus.
