Legacy Lions School Parking Permit 2025-2026

It is understood that students who use the parking area to park their private vehicle park AT THEIR OWN RISK. The school board and the school administration assume NO responsibility for loss or damage to vehicles parked on school grounds NOR are they responsible for articles stolen from vehicles. *Students must adhere to the following:*

- There will **not** be assigned parking spots. Students **must only park in the student parking lot in designated student parking spots. Students must not park in any other areas on campus. If a student's vehicle is parked in a staff or visitor's spot, there will be disciplinary consequences.**
- Students are not permitted to bring cars on campus without a parking placard. Placards must be openly displayed in the vehicle's rearview mirror. Cars on campus without placards after the 2nd week of school (after August 25th), are subject to be booted and/or towed at the owner's expense.
- Students must leave the parking lot by 2:00pm unless they are staying for an approved after-school activity.
- Students are to remain out of their vehicle and the parking area once they have arrived on campus unless they have received official administrative permission. Students should not be in their vehicle or in the parking area during any evacuation drills.
- Students who endanger others by improper use of their vehicles will be denied the privilege of parking on campus and may have discipline consequences. Students are not to cut across open parking spots, use excessive speed (over 5 MPH) or other actions that compromise safety.
- Students who take other students off campus in their vehicles without the proper credentials will result in a loss of driving privileges.
- Dual Enrollment and students with an abbreviated schedule must enter/exit the school through the **Front Entrance** of the school when their scheduled arrival/departure times differ from official school start or end times. These students must carry their student ID with them at all times and provide it when requested. **Consequences:**

1st offense = Driving privileges suspended for 2 weeks or more.

 2^{nd} offense = Driving privileges suspended up to the remainder of the school year.

Note* If student receives a citation in the immediate vicinity surrounding the school (Rangeline or Crosstown) driving privileges are suspended up to 1 year. Tardies and referrals may cause student to lose

parking privileges – # of days to be assessed by Dean

I understand that driving to school and parking on school grounds are privileges. I further understand that failure to obey any of the rules above and/or SLPS Code of Conduct may result in my loss of parking privileges and/or my vehicle searched. If this information changes, I am required to update the office. Cost is \$25 for a parking placard.
