**General Rules for Campaigning**

1. Campaigning officially begins after the candidates have been notified of their eligibility on **8/30/24**. Campaigning will take place from 9/2/24 - 9/5/24.
2. Elections/Voting will take place Friday, 9/6/24 – Sunday, 9/8/24
  - All students will vote via an online survey sent out to student’s school email. Any attempt to vote inappropriately will disqualify the vote.
3. A **maximum of \$25.00** may be spent on campaign materials. Receipts for all materials must be submitted to the sponsors on the morning of **9/2/24**.
4. **No food items may be used for campaigning.**
5. Signs are allowed throughout the campus if there is no potential destruction of school property. Signs must not in any way disrupt the learning atmosphere. Signs that are considered offensive or disruptive will be removed and possible loss of campaigning privileges could result. All posters/signs must be initialed and approved by Mr. Cobb (freshmen, sophomore) or Ms. Octavi (junior, senior).
6. All signs and campaign materials must be appropriate and in good taste.
7. All campaign materials must be cleared from the campus by the end of the school day, 9/6/24. All campaign speeches must be recorded and sent to the appropriate sponsors email below. The speeches should be a **maximum of 2 minutes**. Speeches are due by **9/3/24** to the class sponsors for approval, before being placed into the Class Teams/Canvas groups.
