Car Riders



As our veteran parents will tell you, drop off and pick up the first couple of weeks of school is hectic. Please be patient and remember that the staff is working to keep your student safe at all times and ensure they leave with the correct person. For students' safety:

1. Please remain in your car when picking up your child. If you would like to walk up, please complete the form to have your child exit at the back of the school. Everyone will cross with the assistance of the crossing guard (across from the fire station).
2. Students who are picked up by a parent or other approved adult, will be issued a pink band. If someone without a band is picking up your child, they must go into the office to verify they are on the emergency contact card and show identification.

Walkers

Students who are picked up in the parent walk-up area must be picked up by an approved adult. Please go to the front office to verify you are on the emergency contact list. At that time, you will be issued a pink wrist band with your child's name on it. Be sure to bring it with you every day, so you do not have to check in at the front office again.



Rainy Day

Here's hoping we always have sunshine at dismissal, but we do live in Florida. In the event the weather becomes really nasty (thunder, lightning, blowing rain, etc.) the procedures at pick-up will be slightly different.

Car Riders - All pick-up students will remain inside. As parents pull up to the loading area, we will call student's from the hallway. **It will be a long process.** We appreciate your patience during these days - and remember safety first!

Walk ups- All students will remain inside. After all buses have left (about 3:25) parents / guardians may walk up or drive in the bus loading zone to pick up their student(s). Once it is determined we will follow rainy day procedures, we will continue with rainy day dismissal, even if the weather temporarily clears up.

Walkers & Bike Riders - students walking home on their own will either be held until the weather clears or be brought to the office to make calls indicating they need to be picked up.

Dress Code

LWP students are expected to be in dress code every day. Please refer to the student handbook for the specifics. We ask that parents monitor at home before the child leaves.

However, if hardships arise, please reach out to LWP and we may be able assist with clothing. We want everyone to feel proud to be part of the Falcon Team and do not want anyone excluded due to financial difficulties.
