

We encourage students to take pride in their attire as it relates to the school setting. Students are to dress in a manner that, in addition to the following quidelines, takes into consideration the safety, health, and welfare of self and others, and does not disrupt the learning environment. Appropriateness of dress shall be determined by the school administration according to Governing Board Policy. If there is a dress code violation, he/she will be allowed to change clothing and/or will be subject to disciplinary action.

#### HEAD

- \*NO Sunglasses, Hats, Caps, Visors, Bandanas, Head Covers, or Hoods are permitted to be worn on campus.
- -Earbuds, Beats/headphones, and cell phones MUST be off and put away upon entering our campus.





#### UPPER GARMENTS

- -ALL tops must cover shoulders completely.
- \*NO rips/tears, or see through items and undergarments and cleavage will remain covered.
- -ALL tops may remain untucked, but must be long enough to overlap the beltline.
- \*NO visible midriff.
- \*NO Halter/Tank/Crop or Spaghetti strap tops.
- -ALL graphics must be school appropriate.
- -Hooded sweatshirts are allowed, but hoods MUST remain down while on campus.

### LOWER GARMENTS

- -Leggings/tights/bike shorts must have a top that is fingertip length to cover buttocks.
- -Undergarments and the buttocks MUST remain entirely covered.
- \*NO skin should be exposed above fingertips. Dresses, skirts, and shorts MUST be fingertip length or longer.
- -ALL rips/tears/frays must be BELOW fingertips, and in appropriate places, so that skin is NOT exposed.
- \*NO Pajamas, slippers, CROCS or slides of any kind. ALL shoes must have backs.
