

## Mariposa Dress Code for Students

**Shirts/Blouses:** Collared shirts/blouses with sleeves in any color or pattern are permitted, and must be tucked in. Appropriate logos of pocked size are allowed.

Monday – Friday: Mariposa Spirit Shirts may be worn

Wednesday- College shirts or college team shirts may be worn

**Jeans/Pants/Shorts/Skirts/Leggings:** Jeans, pants, shorts, skirts, and leggings may be worn in any color or pattern with NO rips or tears. Appropriate logos are permitted if discreet. **All shorts and skirts must meet fingertip test for length. No leggings unless covered by school appropriate shorts and skirts. No athletic shorts or sweat suits allowed.**

**Dresses/Jumpers:** Collared dresses and jumpers may be worn in any color or pattern. Logos can be present if discreet. Dresses and jumpers must have sleeves and pass the fingertip test for length. **Shorts should be worn under all skirts, dresses, and jumpers**

**Shoes/Sneakers:** All shoes must have closed toes with a back on them. **No heels, flip flops, or sandals allowed.**

**Outerwear: Sweatshirts/Jackets/Sweaters:** Appropriate logos may be present if discreet. In any color or pattern (no large designs) If clothing item has a hood, the hood *may not* be worn in school.

**Belts:** Must be worn if belt loops are on the pants/shorts. No oversized bely buckles allowed.

**Jewelry:** Earrings must be no larger than quarter size. Neck chains/necklaces are allowed if discreet. No jewelry is permitted if it detracts from learning.

**Hair:** Hair must be clean and neat. No mohawks. Hair cannot be a distraction from learning.

**Head Attire:** No hats or beanies

**Sunglasses:** With a doctor's prescription on file

### Dress Code Violation Consequences:

**1st Offense:** Student warning. Teacher will contact parents to bring a change of clothes and the student may return to class when appropriately dressed.

**2nd Offense:** Lunch detention. Teacher will contact parents to bring a change of clothes.

**3rd Offense:** School Service. (Administration will contact parent.)

**4th Offense:** In-School Suspension (Administration will contact parent.)

**After 4th:** Open defiance of school policy. Out of school suspension with required parent conference.
