Jackets, hoodies, sweatshirts, sweaters	• School-approved shirts must be worn underneath	• Hoods worn on campus

Any student who violates the dress code policy is subject to the following disciplinary actions: lunch detention, after-school detention, Saturday detention, ISS, loss of extracurricular activity

In accordance with Florida State Statute (HB 379), which prohibits student use of wireless communication devices during instructional and non-instruction time. All cell phones, electronic devices, headphones, headsets, and earpods must be turned off and stored out of sight at all times while on campus. These items may not be used, visible, or worn during the school day.

State Law - Each student is prohibited from, while on school grounds during the regular school day, wearing clothing that exposes underwear or body parts in an indecent or vulgar manner or in a manner that disrupts the orderly learning environment. A student who violates this dress policy will be subject to progressive disciplinary actions as outlined in the Code of Conduct.
