<b>Bottoms: pants, jeans, capris, shorts, skirts, jumpers, &amp; dresses</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Any appropriate bottom worn at the natural waistline</li> <li>Knee-length</li> <li>School appropriate graphics/designs/words</li> <li>Leggings allowed in VPK – 2<sup>nd</sup> grade only</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ripped or torn pants (with or without skin showing)</li> <li>Leggings (3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade)</li> <li>See-through/mesh material, spandex, bike shorts, fishnet</li> <li>Sagging pants/pants worn below waistline that expose undergarments</li> <li>Any item that promotes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or violence</li> <li>Any item that is inappropriate, controversial, or offensive</li> </ul>
<b>Jackets, hoodies, sweatshirts, sweaters</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>School appropriate graphics/designs/words</li> <li>School-approved shirts must be worn underneath</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Hoods worn on campus</li> <li>Any item that promotes drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or violence</li> <li>Any item that is inappropriate, controversial, or offensive</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Closed toe with backs or backstraps worn around the heel</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Crocs or Croc-like shoes</li> <li>Slippers</li> <li>Slides</li> <li>Flip-flops or sandals</li> <li>Shoes with wheels</li> </ul>
<b>Jewelry and accessories</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Earrings less than 2 inches long</li> <li>Safe and appropriate</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Spiked jewelry or accessories</li> <li>Chains</li> <li>Bandanas</li> <li>Hats/hoods</li> </ul>
