Student Schedules:

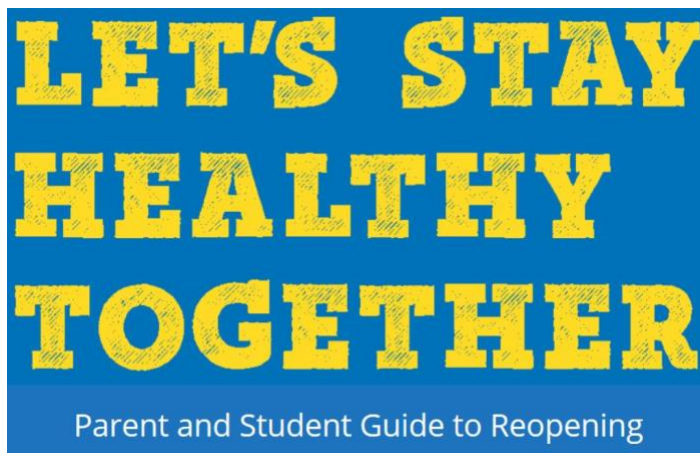
- Students’ schedules will be available in Skyward
- Students log-in using their 56# (username) and lunch number (password)
- Will appear as soon as students are scheduled
- Schedules are still changing due to changes in MySchool Online and traditional enrollment numbers
- Teachers will be reaching out to parents to schedule a Virtual “Meet the Teacher” to give more information regarding their classes

Please remember that immunizations are required for kindergarten and seventh grade students for both virtual and traditional students.



- All parents **MUST** use the **Daily Home Screening Tool** to see if their student has any of the symptoms listed. - Adhere to Health Department quarantine directives.

BUS GUIDELINES

MySchool ONLINE MEAL PICKUP

WEDNESDAY pickup, receive 5 breakfasts and 5 lunches, **3 SIMPLE STEPS**

- 1 LOGIN TO FAMILY ACCESS**
 - Place meal order through family access
 - Login to your family access account
 - Click on "Online Meals"
- 2 ORDER MEALS**
 - Meal orders can be placed Thursday through Saturday
 - Select child on the family access account
 - Request meal date: click drop down
 - Enter Email address
 - Pick up location: click drop down and select pick up location
 - Repeat steps for additional students
- 3 PICKUP MEALS**
 - Meal orders are picked up every Wednesday
 - Pick up meals at selected location
 - Meals can only be picked up at location times
 - Meals can only be picked up through drive through
