

2024-2025 Port St Lucie High School Abbreviated Schedule Request Form

The requirements for a senior privilege and dual enrollment abbreviated schedule are as follows:

- Senior privilege requires students to be on track for graduation: 2.0 unweighted grade point average, on track with credits, met reading/math test requirements, and own transportation to accommodate an abbreviated schedule.
- Seniors that are on track for graduation except the state testing requirements for math and reading, might qualify for an afternoon abbreviated schedule pending they commit to student is signing up for all upcoming SAT/ACT testing opportunities and attends school for all assigned courses and testing opportunities. Students must show up for all required testing opportunities required for graduation.
- Seniors seeking 4-year university admissions should maintain a rigorous academic schedule.
- Seniors must have previously earned an acceleration point or be currently enrolled to complete an acceleration course. Any student not attending their assigned acceleration course will lose their abbreviated schedule privilege.
- No online courses required for graduation unless it is an online dual enrollment elective.
- Must have reliable transportation that allows them to arrive late or leave early for the entire school year.
- Must have a schedule with consecutive classes and no gaps between classes.
- May not transport other students during school hours.
- The **media center is not available** for students wait for next class or until school is over. All students on campus must be assigned to an official class for safety and supervision purposes. If you have an extra -curricular activity after school, you should get an abbreviated schedule to arrive late NOT leave early.
- **Students are required to check school emails daily for news, announcements, and other information.**

Students found on campus (media center, hallways, other teacher’s classes) and/or in any violation of any of the above points will be subject to disciplinary consequences including suspension and loss of privilege schedule (full high school schedule).
