History Day & STEM Updates

History Day - Our 6th and 8th grade Rockets have worked hard this fall on their History Fair projects. Each year, students across the country participate in a research-based project exploring a theme. This year's theme - Rights and Responsibilities - led our students to creating projects on topics related to environmental protections, human rights, governmental decisions, scientific discoveries, and more! The top projects in each grade level have been selected to advance to the school-level of competition, which will culminate with a ceremony on January 16th. From there, representatives from Palm Pointe will be selected to go on and compete in the St. Lucie School District History Day Fair in late February.

STEM - The Palm Pointe STEM fair is a unique way for students to use the scientific process to ask questions and seek answers about the world around them. Students in grades 6-8 gained valuable, hands-on experience with scientific investigation as they completed their projects this past week. Palm Pointe's STEM fair will be on December 11th for those top projects in each grade level. At the fair we will find out who will represent Palm Pointe at the District STEM Fair.

PM2 Assessments

As a reminder, students in Grades 3-8 will take the second administration (PM2) of the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) ELA Reading and Mathematics assessments in early December, while Grades K-2 will test in early January. In November, Gr. 3-8 families received letters with important assessment details. Gr. K-2 families will receive their letters during the first week of December.
