#### **Arrival & Dismissal Procedures**

Thank you for your support with our arrival and dismissal procedures. Please utilize our dismissal system, PikMyKid, for all dismissal needs. If you don't have the app downloaded, contact your child's homeroom teacher, or the front office, who can help you get access. Please use the app for dismissal changes and check for any updates as they are shared through the app such as when inclement weather occurs.

Only students who have the designation of walker have the option to choose "walker". For arrival through the car line, we need your help by having your child(ren) exit the car in the drop off zones from poles 1-10. We are diligent about keeping the line moving and some families do not allow their children to exit the car near pole 10. You cannot always unload at pole 1 as this continues to cause back-ups in our line and all our families want their children to arrive on time for class. Thank you for your assistance in ensuring your child(ren) exit the car at poles 1-10.

Thank you for your patience, as we work to get the K/1 Car Loop up and running. We are making progress! We had the striping and lane delineators installed over the weekend. There is a section of the new loop that needs additional asphalt. We are expecting to have this section completed this week and the loop should be ready for use at the start of next week, barring unexpected delays.

As always, please stay safely buckled inside your vehicle until the car comes to a full stop at drop-off. Please remember to pull all the way up, as far forward, as you can to allow for maximum capacity in the loop. Additionally, please continue to follow the "rules of the road" in the loop, especially at the merging point. Please stay in your lane and be kind to others.

# **Quarter 1 Honor Roll Ceremony**

#### PM 1 Testing

All Gr. K-8 families can access students' FAST PM1 results by clicking on the Cambium Assessments link in the Skyward Family Portal. Your child's homeroom teacher will be sending instructions home with this Friday's grade letter newsletter.

Student results for the FAST PM1 assessments are available for grades 3-8. Please note that because Gr. K-2 testing is facilitated by a 3rd party program, all student scores will be available after the testing window is closed on October 4th. If scores are needed prior to this time, please contact the school. We hope that scores will be visible for all new and returning PPE families by following the outlined directions, but if anyone is unable to do that, reach out to the school for assistance and/or a hard copy.

We are working to finalize our PM2 testing schedule and will share specific dates with you soon. The assessment window for Gr. 3-8 stretches from December 2<sup>nd</sup> until December 20th, while the window for Gr. K-2 lasts from December 2<sup>nd</sup> until January 24th.
