FAST Progress Monitoring 2

The Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) is the progress monitoring tool that is administered three times per year for all K-8 students to track student progress in learning the Benchmarks of Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) standards throughout this school year. Third grade through Eighth grade will take the FAST Reading and Math progress monitoring assessments.

Grades 3 and 4 will take the FAST Reading on Jan. 18, 2023 and the FAST Math on Jan. 19, 2023.

Grades 5 and 6 will take the FAST Reading on Jan. 11, 2023 and the FAST Math on Jan. 12, 2023.

Grades 7 and 8 will take the FAST Reading on Jan. 9, 2023 and the FAST Math on Jan. 10, 2023.

Your student's results from PM2 are for informational purposes only, and the results are posted to your child's Skyward account after testing is completed. If you or your student would like to interact with the online testing platform or review FAST Reading and Mathematics sample items at home, sample test materials are available at https://flfast.org/families.html.

A positive test experience begins at home with a restful night's sleep before the test date, a nutritious breakfast (at home or school!) and being on time to begin the school day. Please help your child be present for these test days.


Family Grade Level Events in January

REGISTRATION for 2023-2024

Registration for the **2023-2024** school year is open from September 1, 2022 - February 1, 2023. FAU will begin selecting students in March, beginning with Kindergarten. You must apply for the lottery for a new student each year, even if you already have siblings here at PPE.

Cultural Learning Environment (CLE)

Our CLE trait of the month is kindness and compassion. Compassion is the feeling that arises when you perceive another's suffering and feel motivated to relieve that suffering. When compassion leads to action, the result is called kindness.

The key to having children actively demonstrate kindness, courtesy, and compassion is to train our minds to notice those acts when they occur.
