#### Social Emotional Learning

The Social Emotional Learning topic for this month is resilience. Resilience is defined as the set of attributes that provides people with the strength and fortitude to confront the overwhelming obstacles they are bound to face in life. As a parent, raising resilient children is possible and provides kids with the tools to respond to the challenges of adolescence and young adulthood to navigate through adulthood. Dr. Kenneth Ginsburg has identified seven "Cs" of resilience, recognizing that "Resilience isn't a simple, one-part entity." The seven "Cs" are, competence, confidence, connection, character, contribution, coping, and control. Students are encouraged to wear a blue uniformed collared shirt on March 11th to celebrate National SEL Day! As a school, we will celebrate resiliency on March 25th. #### **COVID Procedures**

Any student displaying any of the symptoms listed on the Daily Home Screener must stay home to protect the safety and wellbeing of others. While at school, if your child reports to the clinic exhibiting one of the symptoms on the screening tool, parents will be called to pick up their child and he/she must stay home until symptom free and fever free without fever reducing medications for 24 hours. #### (stlucie.k12.fl.us)

A student with a positive home or lab test, and is symptomatic, will be quarantined from school for 5 days beginning from the date of symptoms starting. Students can return on day 6 if they are fever free for 24 hours and symptoms are improving. A student with a positive home or lab test, and is

asymptomatic, will be quarantined from school for 5 days beginning from the date of when positive test was

taken. Students can return on day 6 if they are fever free for 24 hours and symptoms, if any develop, are improving. Please notify the school if your student has a positive COVID-19 test or if you have any questions.

If someone in your family tests positive for COVID-19 or is awaiting test results, we ask that you please keep your child(ren) at home and contact Mr. Keelor or Mrs. DeGarmo at (772) 345-3245.
