An important Referendum Renewal is on the November ballot. Early voting begins October 24th and runs through November 5th. Election Day is November 8th. It provides a school resource officer on every campus, supports the recruitment and retention of high-quality teachers, expands mental health services for students and supports special programs such as art and music in our schools.

#### **Parent & Family Engagement Events**

#### **FAST and Star Progress Monitoring Score Reports**

Parents can locate scores for their child's performance on the FAST and/or Star Early Literacy, Literacy and Math progress monitoring on Skyward. The "Portfolio" tab opens to an "Attachment" tab (report cards are also posted here) where student scores and an Individual Score Report can be found. This first Progress Monitoring check establishes a baseline score and provides data to teachers for instructional mapping.
