School Safety

The 2018-2019 School Year is off to a great start!

Palm Pointe maintains a strong commitment to ensuring safety for all students and staff. Please note that new protocols are in place for entering the school. When you come to school, please press the buzzer and state your purpose. Once verified, you will be buzzed into the building. Visitors are not permitted to hold the door open for others. It is important that you present a form of identification as one of the necessary steps to receive your "Visitor Badge." We ask that all visitors enter and exit through the main office. Lunch

Thank you for allowing time for our students to develop routines and independence in the audeteria. We encourage limited visits so that students can continue to socialize and develop a sense of independence. Visitors are not permitted to eat at the student's lunch table. Special tables are set up at the front of the audeteria or you may eat outside in the picnic area with your child(ren) only. Please do not allow your child or sibling on the playground during lunch. It is a liability concern and we appreciate your cooperation. Adult lunches are \$3.00. Please sign in at the front office to receive a visitor pass before proceeding to lunch and exit back through the front office to sign out. If anyone other than a parent wants to come for lunch, a written note must be received in advance of the guest to be permitted to the audeteria. The visitor will need to bring a valid ID to be checked into school.
