### Music with Mr. Epting



What's Happening in the Science Lab?

The school year is off to a great start in the science lab!

Students in grades K and I have been learning about making observations by using a hand lens to look at caterpillars eating milkweed leaves. They are also looking at chrysalis and learning about the life cycle of butterflies. Thanks to the Allen family for donating the milkweed plants with so many caterpillars on them.

Students in grades 2-5 are learning about the Scientific Method by causing chemical reactions using baking soda and vinegar and effervescent tablets and water. They are using film canisters and seeing how many times the lids will pop off when they cause chemical reactions inside the canisters.
