If it is not listed below, the student is out of dress code

Uniform Style	Non-Uniform Style Denim/Khaki
Belted pants or shorts in <b>any solid color</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o must extend beyond the fingertips</li></ul>	Jeans, shorts, skirts or capris in <b>any solid color except white.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o Solid denim/khaki without graphics/embellishments or frayed, cut, damaged/destroyed – <b>no fleece/sweatpants.</b></li><li>o No visible underwear</li><li>o Belts if there are belt loops (buckles smaller than 2 inches)</li><li>o Shorts/skirts must extend beyond the fingertips</li></ul>
Jumpers or skirts in <b>any solid color</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o must extend beyond the fingertips</li></ul>	Collared Polo <b>Dresses/Shirts or school spirit shirt ONLY</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o No more than 2 buttons unfastened</li><li>o Any solid color or stripe</li><li>o Graphics may be no larger than pocket-sized</li><li>o Shirts must be long enough to remain tucked in when seated.</li></ul>

No unnatural hair color – no unnatural hues

Shoes/tennis shoes must have a back or back strap (straps/laces must be properly fastened)

- no shoes with wheels

Jewelry must be less than ½ inch in size

- pierced ears only are permitted (earrings should be no longer than 2 inches below the ear)
- plain or charm style necklaces

Clothing on the bottom should fit properly above the waist, not baggy.

Full length jackets and sweaters only, must extend to the waist.

**School spirit shirts/Team shirts may be worn on any day.**

**\*\*State Law – Each student is prohibited from, while on school grounds during the regular school day, wearing clothing that exposes underwear or body parts in an indecent or vulgar manner or in a manner that disrupts the orderly learning environment. A student who violates this dress policy will be subject to progressive disciplinary actions as outlined by the Code of Conduct.**
