
What is PBIS?

WHY IS PBIS IMPORTANT?

Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS)...

- Aims to build effective environments in which positive behavior is more effective than problem behavior.
- Is a collaborative, assessment-based approach to developing effective interventions for problem behavior.
- Emphasizes the use of preventative, teaching, and reinforcementbased strategies to achieve meaningful and durable behavior and lifestyle outcomes.
