



SOUTHPORT MIDDLE SCHOOL 2020-2021 DRESS CODE GUIDELINES:

Shirts: Please note that all students are required to wear solid color crewneck Southport Middle School t-shirts, Cane Character shirts or Southport Middle School spirit/club shirts. Various colors of the required t-shirts will be available. Spirit t-shirts include band, drama, PE, class or team t-shirts that represent Southport Middle School. School t-shirts will be sold in the book store located in the 600 building from 9:15-9:40 a.m. or online. Pants/Shorts/Skirts: All pants must be worn at the waist without visible undergarments. Students may wear solid colored, plaid or patterned pants, shorts, skirts or jeans. All clothing must fit appropriately and cannot reveal significant portions of skin on the upper leg/thigh. Administration reserves the right to determine overall appropriateness. Lewd or graphic pictures and writing are not allowed on clothing. Skirt or shorts must be knee length. **SWEAT PANTS, KNIT JOGGERS, GYM SHORTS, FLANNELS, SWIM WEAR, PAJAMA BOTTOMS AND DRESSES ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

Jackets/sweaters/sweatshirts: Only garments intended as outerwear such as JACKETS, SWEATERS, or SWEATSHIRTS may be worn OVER the Southport Middle School t-shirt. All other styled shirts including collared, long sleeve t-shirts, flannels or thermals must be worn under the Southport Middle School t-shirt. **Hoods may not be worn on the head.; and students with repeated violations will lose the privilege to wear a hooded sweatshirt.**

Shoes: Shoes must be flat and have closed toes and closed backs. Sneakers are strongly suggested for both boys and girls. **FLIP FLOPS AND SLIPPERS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**

Other garments: Hats, caps, visors, and sunglasses (unless prescribed by a doctor) are not permitted on school grounds. Ear buds may not be worn around the neck or undershirts while on campus (Used only during online instruction.)
