Expectations

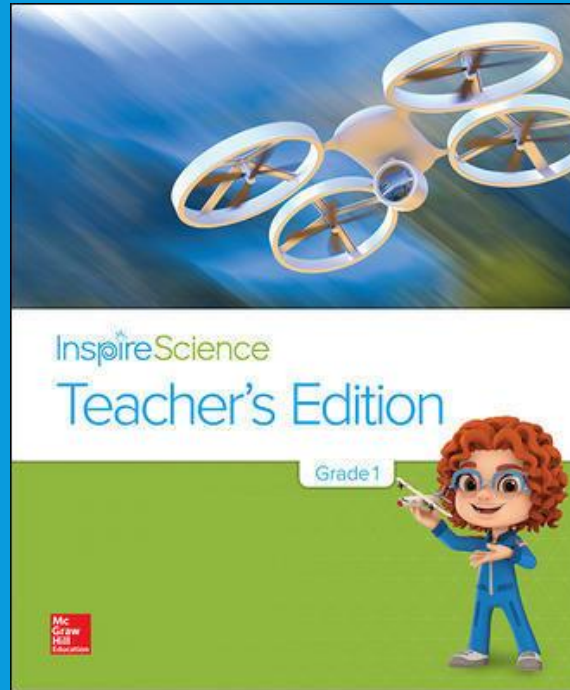
- come to school every day ready to learn

- 30 minutes daily either science or SS

ELA

- Tests after each unit
- 90 minutes a day
- Daily 5
- Whole group as well as small group for differentiation based on student's academic needs
- Sight words- per quarter, broken down by 5 weekly

Writing

- Embedded into all subject areas
- 45 minutes a day
- We use a 5 day systematic program which encompasses the conventions of writing and the writing process from planning to completed sample.

Math

- Test after every Unit
- We cover multiple domains: numbers and operations in base 10, operations and algebraic thinking, geometry, measurement and data.
- Key concepts within these domains:
- Time, graphing, addition and subtraction within 20, place value within 99, etc.

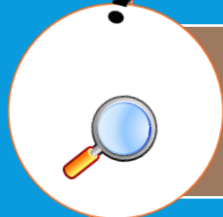
