- o 24 Core Credits for Standard Diploma
 - 4 English Credits
 - 4 Math Credits must include Algebra 1 and Geometry
 - 3 History Credits World History, American History, American Government/ Economics with Financial Literacy
 - 3 Science Credits must include Biology
 - HOPE class
 - 1 Performing Arts Credit
 - 8 Elective Credits
 - Must pass FSA Reading Exam or have a passing concordant score for ELA from SAT or ACT
 - Must pass Algebra 1 EOC Exam or have a PSAT, SAT, or ACT Math passing concordant score
