2023 USNA SUMMER PROGRAMS ANNOUNCEMENT

As many of you know, the New Year brings our official launch of the Summer Program season with the opening of the Naval Academy Summer Seminar and Summer STEM applications. These programs are crucial to our outreach efforts here in the Office of Admissions, typically bringing in more than 3,300 high school students during the month of June.

Both the **NASS and STEM** applications opened **TODAY** at 9:00 a.m. (EST). Applications close on April 15, *a shift to note from previous years*. In support of the opening days, the Summer Programs team will be on DUTY today through Friday.

A key document to print and have handy is: **ATTACHED**.

At the moment, key announcements for 2023:

- The applications close on April 15, 2023.
- The applications are now **savable** so do NOT need to be completed in one sitting.
- At the moment, participants are required to be vaccinated to include completion of the DD3150 Form in advance of the program start.
- Selections will be made on a **rolling** basis beginning in late January/early February. All applicants to either program will be notified of their status (selection, pre-determined waitlist or turndown) via the email noted on their application no later than 28 APR 2023.
- Please reassure parents/students calling in that applications are reviewed with many factors in mind, to include ensuring geographical representation from the entire country along with the overall accomplishments of the students, but is **not** done on a first come, first served basis. Test scores are NOT required for Summer Seminar and Summer STEM. If they have scores, ask them to input the unofficial scores but, again, they are not required and Admissions is able to review their applications without test scores.
- In the coming weeks, ACs/BGOs will be sent the process for recommending students for the programs.
