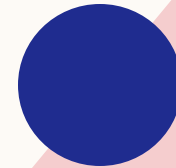

# HONORS/ HIGH HONORS

## HONORS CORD

- \$10 cash ONLY at cap and gown distribution
- Single silver cord
- 3.0 weighted GPA or higher
- Guidance will send school email with list of those that are eligible to purchase

## HIGH HONORS CORD & TASSEL

- \$20 cash ONLY at cap and gown distribution
- Double silver cord and silver tassel
- 3.8 weighted GPA or higher
- Guidance will send school email with list of those that are eligible to purchase



# OTHER CORDS AND DISTINCTIONS

\*\*All cords and distinctions for graduation besides honors and high honors are determined by the programs teacher or sponsor and can be purchased directly from them.

\*\*If you are unsure if your program has a cord/distinction for graduation check with the teacher or sponsor.

\*\*There are NO cords or distinctions for athletics-athletics gets senior nights.

# GRADUATION CLASS OF 2023

- Thursday May 25, 2023 8am
- Lawnwood Stadium Fort Pierce
- Student arrival time 7am
- If possible, please limit the amount of cars by carpooling with guests to the stadium.
- The amount of tickets each graduate will get is a district decision and will be announced closer to graduation
- TICKETS WILL BE GIVEN AT CAP AND GOWN DISTRIBUTION ONLY
- ALL guests must have a ticket- including babies as per SLPS guidelines
- NO balloons, large signs, or blow horns allowed in stadium
- NO GRADUATION CAPS CAN BE DECORATED as per SLPS guidelines
- Dress under gowns is business casual- remember it is outside in the heat
- Shoes- remember all students will be on the grass football field- do NOT recommend heels

# GRADUATION CONTINUED...

- Students arrive at south gate of stadium and will be directed to get their name card
- Name cards say graduate name and seat row and number... must sit in assigned seat
- Graduates **MUST** bring name cards up to stage for their name to be called
- At end of ceremony students will exit the seating area and be directed to back of stadium to get diplomas
