

# CRIMINAL JUSTICE 1, 2, 3, 4

- CJ1 – an introduction to our criminal justice system. Content includes the structure, goals and values of the criminal justice system, constitutional and criminal laws, the courts, the pretrial and trial processes, and corrections. We also cover careers in criminal justice, ethics and professionalism, and employability skills.
- CJ2 focuses on law enforcement. Content includes the history of police, patrol procedures, crime prevention, constitutional law as it relates to police practices, including search and seizure, Miranda warnings, and guidelines for use of force. Students will also receive instruction and training in interview skills, writing reports, traffic control procedures, and CPR/first aid. Students also have an opportunity to earn certification in ESB (Entrepreneurial and Small Business).
- CJ3 – an introduction to CSI. Coursework includes criminal investigations, forensics, and evidence-handling. Students will learn the basics of fingerprint evidence, blood spatter analysis, ballistics, and DNA fingerprinting.
- CJ4 prepares students for the ALP exam. Students who pass the exam receive certification as Accredited Legal Professionals, opening doors for employment in the legal industry. CJ4 is not a required course to complete the Academy.

# MORE INFORMATION ON CJ PROGRAM

- Students who complete the Criminal Justice Academy at SLWCHS (CJ1, CJ2, and CJ3) will earn 9 college credits.
- All levels of the Academy provide students with real-life experiences - a chance to observe and practice what people in the criminal justice field do every day. Guest speaker: military, law enforcement, emergency management, and attorneys; Demonstrations: K-9 handler, traffic stop, and drone team; Mock trial participation; Field trips: to IRSC and Keiser University, the Law Library, Clerk's Office, and the Federal Courthouse.
- Whether you are interested in becoming a police officer, FBI agent, crime scene investigator, criminal psychologist, lawyer, paralegal, or private security officer, the Criminal Justice Academy is for you.
