



St Lucie West Centennial HS **Code of Conduct 2024-2025**

Centennial High School Administration (Principal, Athletic Director) will make the final decision on the eligibility of student athletes. We reserve the right to grant an exemption or make consequences more severe depending on the circumstance.

Academic Policy

STUDENTS WHO HAVE A 2.5 CUMULATIVE GPA AT THE BEGINNING OF THE SEMESTER ARE NOT SUBJECT TO THE ACADEMIC POLICY UNLESS AT THE REQUEST OF ADMINISTRATION OR THE COACH OF THE STUDENT ATHLETE. ALL INCOMING 9TH GRADE STUDENTS WITHOUT A REGISTERED GPA WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE ACADEMIC POLICY

- Failure report is run every Monday starting with the 3rd week of the 9 weeks. Non-participation consequence begins at the beginning of 4th week of the 9 weeks.
- Failing grades must be for 2 consecutive weeks for the athlete to be subject to Academic Policy consequences.
- Tutoring/Study Hall will be held on Monday's and Tuesday's only. Tutoring obligation must be met prior to returning to practice or competition.

Number of Failing Classes (for consecutive weeks)	Consequence
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must attend tutoring for 1hr • <u>Student may still participate in practice /compete * coaches' decision after tutoring obligation is met</u>
Number of Failing Classes (for consecutive weeks)	Consequence
2 or more	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must attend tutoring for <u>each</u> failing class for a minimum of 1hr • No participation in pre/post season conditioning or competitions. Practice would be coaches' decision after tutoring obligation is met.

Attendance Policy

- To participate in practice/condition/competition, the student athlete must be at school no later than the end of 2nd block. Student athletes will need to provide a note from the attendance office approving them as excused to be exempt from this rule.
- If the student athlete is absent from school, they will be unable to participate in practice/conditioning/competition for that day.
- If the student athlete is absent on a Friday, they will be unable to practice/condition/competition on Saturday
- If student athletes fall below 90% attendance to school for the season, they will be given a consequence that reduces the amount of playing time they are permitted.
- Any student who appears on the Dean's list for tardiness, and earns a lunch detention for tardiness, will also serve a 1 game suspension for athletics (Football ½ of game)

Discipline Policy

<u>Discipline Issue</u>	<u>Consequence</u>
BIC	No practice/conditioning/competition for that day
1 Day OSS	Suspended from practice/conditioning/competition for 1 week
2 Days OSS	Suspended from practice/conditioning/competition for 2 weeks
3 Days OSS	Removal from team for the remainder of the athletic season

Skipping Class / Tardy Policy

- Centennial High School students who skip class 3 times will be ineligible for any school activities (including sports and practices) for 9 weeks.
- The date of the 3rd processed referral will determine the date the student can return to school activities. That return date will be 9 weeks after the 3rd processed referral, regardless of where that falls in the school calendar. The student's dean will let the student athlete and parent know what the return date will be.
- For every tardy the student athlete incurs, they will be required to sit out 15 minutes of practice time.
