OUTBOARD MARINE SERVICE AND MARINE TECHNOLOGY




This program offers a sequence of instruction which will prepare students with the necessary skills for entry level positions within the marine field. The course content is a rigorous combination of Electrical and Mechanical skills which fall under the Florida Department of Education performance standards for the marine industry. The content of the instruction follows the ABYC standards, and the Safety Requirements outlined in 29 CFR 1910 Occupational Safety and Health Standards for General Industry. Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of Outboard engines, 2 and 4 stroke, Inboard Gasoline engines and drive systems as well as a variety of other Marine systems. Students will also learn about the business side of the marine industry to include keeping track of billable hours, maintaining accountability of materials and EPA requirements covered in the Clean Marina program.
