NJROTC requires students to wear a uniform once a week & after school practices are part of the program

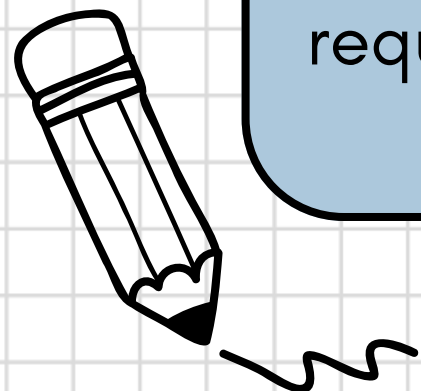



