- Document how much you volunteer (even if the organization does it as well) & return your paperwork to your school after you make a copy for yourself. This is how you get your hours logged in Skyward.
- If volunteering offsite, the organization will need to put the volunteer work details on their letterhead (see your School Counselor, if you have any questions).
- Set specific days and times to volunteer.
