DUAL ENROLLMENT/SENIOR PRIVILEGE POLICY

ST. LUCIE WEST CENTENNIAL HIGH SCHOOL POLICY FOR STUDENTS WITH LESS THAN 7 CLASSES ON CAMPUS

The requirements for students wanting this privilege are as follows:

- Senior privilege students must have a 2.0 unweighted Cumulative/Core GPA and be on track for graduation.
- Senior must have previously received an acceleration point or currently be enrolled in an acceleration course/CTE Certification course.
- Dual enrollment students must have a 3.0 unweighted cumulative GPA and pass the PERT test.
- Must have transportation that allows them to arrive late or leave early.
- Must have a schedule with consecutive classes and no gaps between classes.
- Must turn in this signed notarized parental consent form to their School Counselor.
- May not transport other students during school hours.
- Per school board policy students may not take more than 7 classes total per semester (SLWCHS, IRSC, FLVS).







Get Ready for College

- Use online resources to research colleges, college programs & scholarships (Xello, College Board, college websites, etc.)
- Plan for college visits, college open house events, & attend on campus college info sessions
- Ask English teacher for help with college entrance essay
- Sign up for SAT/ACT & request fee waivers (must be eligible for free/reduced lunch)
- Request recommendation letters early
- Submit volunteer/work hours through Helper Helper
- Plan for a rigorous senior schedule (AICE, AP, DE classes)

Registration Checklist

TAKE YOUR FIRST STEP TO BECOMING AN NCAA STUDENT-ATHLETE

If you want to play NCAA sports at a Division I or II school, you must register with the NCAA Eligibility Center at eligibilitycenter.org. Plan to register during your freshman year of high school.

To get started, choose from our two account types:

- 1. Profile Page Account: If you plan to compete at an NCAA Division III school or are currently unsure in which division you want to compete, create a free Profile Page account. If at any time you wish to pursue a Division I or II path, you can transition your Profile Page to a Certification account.
- 2. Certification Account: You must be certified by the Eligibility Center to compete at an NCAA Division I or II school. Before you can make official visits or sign a National Letter of Intent, you must have a completed Certification account (including submitted payment or fee waiver).











