# Transcript Requests

- Transcript requests prior to June can be requested from Ms. Feldman at [araima.feldman@stlucieschools.org](mailto:araima.feldman@stlucieschools.org)
- For electronic transcripts to schools only
- Official transcripts will be final and ready in June. A form to request them and where to send them will be available at cap and gown distribution.
- All students lacking one or more graduation requirements will have letters sent home
- Students must know what they need to graduate at this point – if not meet with school counselor

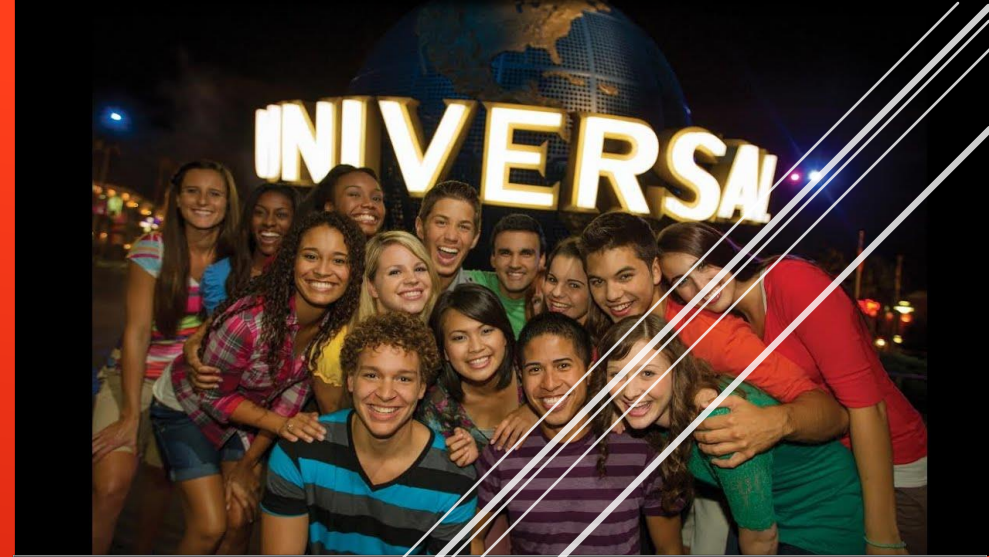

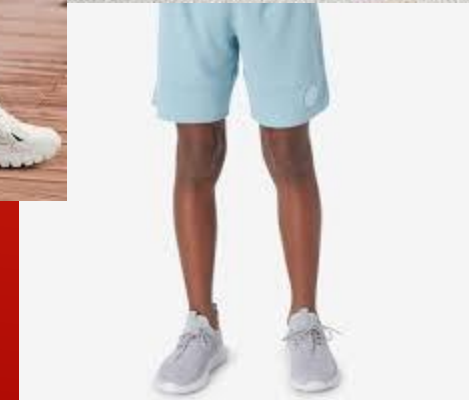

# MAY 21ST, GRADUATION

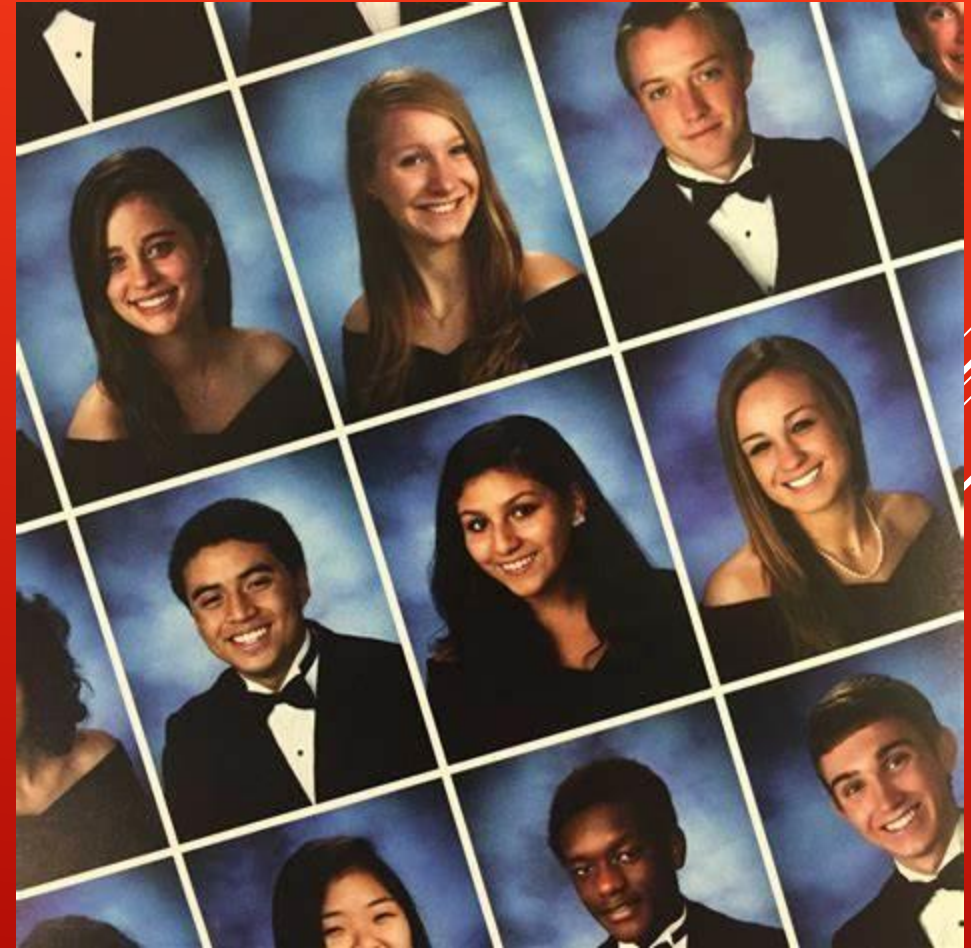
- Students arrive at 3:00pm

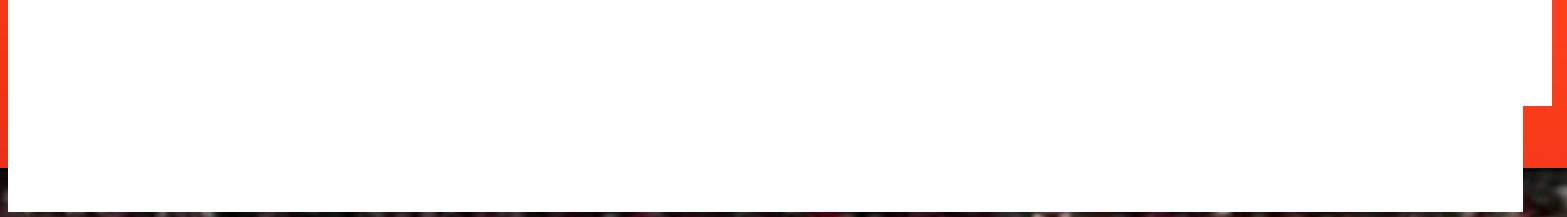
