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CRITERIA:

- Eligible for High School Graduation
- A minimum 2.5 unweighted GPA
- A minimum of 50 community service hours documented on official High School transcript
- Enrolled in an accredited public, charter, parochial or private school in South Florida
- Demonstrates accomplishments in: Specialized talents, leadership, extracurricular, athletics, and/or community service

REQUIREMENTS:

- Completed application
- **Current High School Transcript with official seal in a sealed envelope**
- 3 letters of recommendation from non-family members (one must be from an educator)
- Written essay
- Evidence of your acceptance from a post-secondary institution
- Photograph of applicant

ESSAY:

On a separate sheet of paper, please choose ONE of the two essay topics to discuss. Use 12-point font, TIMES NEW ROMAN, double-spaced, 600-word maximum.

1. Describe a time in which you have made a meaningful contribution to others where the “greater good” was your focus. Discuss any challenges or rewards that were brought forth because of your contribution.
2. What does it mean to you to be a *leader* in society today as a high school senior? How do you plan on developing and using your leadership skills in the future?
