ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS



Currently enrolled high school/home-schooled students attending school in one of the 50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, or select DoD schools who will graduate high school during the 2026-2027 academic school year



U.S. Citizens, U.S. Nationals, U.S. Permanent Residents (not Temporary Residents), Refugees, Asylees, Cuban-Haitian Entrants, OR Humanitarian Parolees – based on the guidelines utilized by U.S. Department of Education for Federal Financial Aid eligibility – must meet eligibility at time of submitting this application; those with pending applications should not apply.



Planning to pursue a degree at an accredited U.S. college or university



INELIGIBLE APPLICANTS



Children or grandchildren of current employees, officers, or owners of Coca-Cola bottling companies, The Coca-Cola Company, Company divisions or subsidiaries



Children or grandchildren of former employees, officers, or owners of Coca-Cola bottling companies, The Coca-Cola Company, Company divisions or subsidiaries who are currently receiving retirement benefits from those entities



Students attending school outside of the 50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, or Puerto Rico (with the exception of students attending select DoD schools; students graduating from an American or expat school abroad or from a U.S. territory not referenced above are not eligible for this award, even if they meet the other criteria)



High school graduates (if you received a high school diploma prior to the 2026-2027 school year, you are not eligible)



Temporary Residents (if your permanent legal residence is outside the U.S., you are not eligible)
