# GRADUATION

- MAY 24<sup>th</sup>, 8am Lawnwood Stadium
- NO CAP DECORATING
- Each graduate will receive tickets for the ceremony from their school and should arrive in one car with their guests. All guests, including children and babies, require a ticket.
- The use of face masks will be optional for outdoor graduations.
- Any high-risk individuals or those who are susceptible to the heat should consider staying home and watching the live broadcast of the ceremony.
- All graduates must arrive at least 1 hour before the start of the ceremony.
- Upon arrival, all graduates will go directly to their assigned seats on the field. Graduates will be seated 6 feet from one another. Each graduate will be provided a bottle of water.
- Each graduate will have the opportunity to walk across the stage to be recognized during the roll call. However, graduates will not shake hands on stage.
- When the ceremony ends, all graduates and visitors will immediately exit the stadium as directed, while continuing to socially distance themselves from one another.
- Bags and coolers will not be permitted; however, guests may bring bottled water. All graduates and guests are encouraged to bring umbrellas to provide shade from the sun.
