



Treasure Coast High School Dress Code

All Students MUST:	<u>Students are NOT permitted to wear:</u>
Be covered from shoulders to knees. This includes any pants that have rips or frays. Clothing with any holes or tears above the knee must be covered by fabric (sewn-in material or tights underneath jeans).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sunglasses or any head covering including, but not limited to hats, bandanas (including flags), wave caps, hair nets, or shower caps. • Biking/compression shorts, leggings, jeggings, flared leggings, yoga pants, or onesie pajamas. • Clothing with writing below the waistline. • Backless shoes, slides, house shoes, flip flops, and slippers. Crocs must be worn with the back strap around the heel. • Accessories and /or jewelry considered unsafe (brass knuckle type rings, studded belts, chains on pants, etc.). Bandanas (including flags) are not allowed to be worn or displayed at all on campus. • Sheer (see-through) fabrics. Undergarments must not be visible or outlined (through both loose or form-fitted clothing). • Sleeveless shirts, tanks, or camisole tops or shirts that expose the midriff or cleavage (crop tops), or shirts with cutouts. • Clothing that is offensive, promotes violence, alcohol, tobacco, drugs or has the potential to compromise safety. • Earbuds or headphones in academic areas. • Athletic shorts, skirts, dresses, flat front shorts, etc. that do not hit at the knee.
Dress code violation consequences:	
<p>1st- BIC until fixed Behavior Incident Report (BIR)</p> <p>2nd- BIC until fixed Behavior Incident Report (BIR) Lunch Detention</p> <p>3rd-BIC for the remainder of the day Level 1 referral (D1-Dress Code) 60 minute after-school detention</p> <p>4th-BIC for the remainder of the day Level 1 referral (D1- Dress Code) Saturday School Detention</p> <p>5th (or more)–BIC for the remainder of the day Level 2 referral (G2 - Open Defiance of School Policy) Saturday School Detention Mandatory Parent Conference</p>	
Teachers may designate days for Professional Dress. These days must adhere to the school dress code with the exception to scrubs worn by Medical students and JROTC uniforms.
