- **3. Principal Report**: Mr. Lehman shared celebrations; Homecoming spirit week. All our students were able to participate in various events throughout the week such as themed days, activities during lunch, pep rally, football game on Friday evening, and dance Saturday evening. Shared FAST ELA and BEST ALG retake data. Mr. Grundstrom has been selected to receive the 2023 Gutterman Family Outstanding Holocaust Educator Award from the Arthur and Emalie Gutterman Center for Holocaust and Human Rights Education at Florida Atlantic University.

4. Leadership Team Reviews/Updates

Mr. Monroe – 9^{th} : Mr. Monroe shared; incoming 9^{th} grade open house is scheduled for Feb 22^{nd} 5:30-7PM. This is open to current 8^{th} grade students who will be attending Treasure Coast High School for the 24-25 School Year.

Mrs. Emerson – 10^{th} : Ms. Kosinski shared for Ms. Emerson; the student compact letter was provided to all attendees and a QR code was shared requesting feedback on the student compact letter.

Mr. Oge – 11^{th} : Mr. Oge provided attendees with the triple time ACT flyer. The triple time ACT is a non-college reportable exam. It is used to fulfill the reading and math score graduation requirement.

Ms. Roberts – 12^{th} : Ms. Roberts shared; the Triple Time ACT for seniors will take place after the juniors because we are pending SAT scores. SAT was offered last week; scores will be dispersed to students by November 1st. CPR was offered to our 11th grade students. 9th and 10th grade ELA completed their first unit assessment. The results are in line with the district average.

Mr. Wile – AICE: Mr. Wile shared; students are currently completing AICE retakes from the June 2023 testing series. 110 individual tests are being taken by 80 different candidates. Testing will conclude by the end of this month. Students are preparing for the June 2024 test series. Certificates will be distributed by the end of November for those students that passed exams in the June 2023 testing series.

5. Review Requests to Purchase Books: Ms. Heather Bolitho, SLPS Office of Teaching and Learning shared; Florida Teen Reads geared for students 9-12th grade and Sunshine State Young Readers Award geared for students 6-8th grade. Each attendee was provided a list of 30 book titles to seek input from parents.

Guidance Report: Mr. Welch shared; there was a slight change is alpha breakdown for each counselor due to the influx of English Language Learner students who now will have a designated school counselor. Apply Yourself Workshop was a huge success for the seniors with over 300 students submitting a college application. Within the next two weeks, 1 of the 300 seniors will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Signs of Suicide presentation was given in all freshman seminar classes. This is a state mandate. Following the presentation, each student was given the opportunity to seek additional assistance and we had over 40 students take that opportunity. School counselors are currently completing senior credit checks for graduation. College visits and tours are ongoing.
