Current demographics of TCHS are 3150 students, 120 teachers, 65 additional staff, 63% economically disadvantaged (free-reduced lunch). Mr. Lehman reviewed the school improvement plan and the four areas of need; instructional practice specifically relating to ELA, instructional practice specifically relating to math, increased student enrollment in-future focused opportunities, and positive culture and environment specifically relating to single school culture and climate. **4. Opportunity for Parent/Stakeholder Input Request to Purchase Books:** This agenda item is new to SAC for the 23-24 school year. The books for review include, As You Like It by William Shakespeare, Blood Wedding by Pierre Lemaître, Long Day's Journey into Night by Eugene O'Neil, and Cat on a Hot Tin Roof by Tennessee Williams. These books will be used in AICE classes, specifically AICE English Literature and AICE Drama. Parent input was requested. No parent input was provided. Mr. Lehman will move forward with approving the request.
