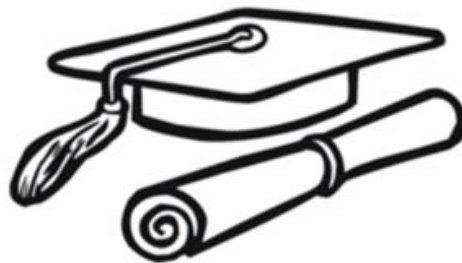

All communication this year will take place on the TCHS Class of 2022 page in Microsoft Teams. Please make sure you have the Microsoft Teams application (App) downloaded on your phone to receive immediate updates.

Graduation Requirements

- 24 Core Credits for Standard Diploma
 - **4 English Credits**
 - **4 Math Credits – must include Algebra 1 and Geometry**
 - **3 History Credits – World History, American History, American Government/ Economics with Financial Literacy**
 - **3 Science Credits – must include Biology**
 - **HOPE class**
 - **1 Performing Arts Credit**
 - **8 Elective Credits**
- 1 of the 24 Credits must be an online class (Economics on campus will fulfill this requirement)
- Must pass FSA Reading Exam or have a passing concordant score for ELA (ACT or SAT)
- Must pass Algebra 1 EOC Exam or have a PERT Math passing Concordant Score

REFUND POLICY

If you have paid your graduation fees and do not graduate in 2022, but you return to Treasure Coast High School in the fall of 2022-2023 school year as a 2nd year Senior, the Senior fee for the Class of 2023 will be waived.

If you do not graduate in June of 2022 and do not return to Treasure Coast High School, NO refund will be issued.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ATTENDING SENIOR ACTIVITIES

Seniors must:

1. HAVE A GOOD ATTENDANCE RECORD.

- A. Excessive absences may result in your NOT being allowed to participate in Senior Activities. No more than four (4) unexcused absences per quarter.
- B. Special circumstances will be addressed and considered on an individual basis.
- C. Remember that all notes for absences need to be turned into the attendance office within 3 days. The note should include first and last name, and student identification number. (56...)

2. Be a Senior of Record (17 or more COMPLETED credits, 2.0 unweighted GPA)

- A. School records must verify you are classified as a senior, (at the beginning of the year for first semester activities, at the beginning of second semester for second semester activities), and will graduate in June 2022.

3. HAVE A GOOD DISCIPLINE RECORD

- A. Subject to approval by administration, the deans, and the senior sponsors. No level 3 offenses or higher.

4. TURN IN CORRECTLY COMPLETED and SIGNED PERMISSION FORMS BY THE SPECIFIED DATE

- A. **THE ONLY ACCEPTABLE SIGNATURE** for parent/guardian permission for participation in a Senior Trip/Activity is the signature of the Parent or Guardian unless a senior has filed Emancipation Papers with the Attendance Office.

5. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

- A. ALL FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS MUST BE PAID IN FULL TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL SENIOR ACTIVITIES.

At Treasure Coast High School, it is expected that ALL students will be on their best behavior at all senior activities. **Seniors who do not follow the rules at any of the senior activities will NOT be permitted to attend other senior functions.** You may also be subject to a discipline referral, along with disciplinary action.

SENIOR PINNING CEREMONY

The Senior Pinning Ceremony will be held

Senior Pinning Requirements: Students enrolled at TCHS prior to ceremony date and have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and have earned 21/24 credits (Standard Diploma) or have earned 15/18 credits (ACCEL Diploma).

Dress code: Seniors should dress professionally in shirt, tie, dress pants, dress socks, dress shoes OR appropriate length dresses, dress pants and a blouse, skirt and a blouse, dress shoes with backs (skirts and dresses should be no more than one inch above the knee). **No sneakers or jeans for anyone.**

Cap/Gown for Graduation

The cost of Cap/Gown are NOT included with Treasure Coast High's Senior Fees. These items are all purchased through Herff Jones Orlando.

The deadline for Cap and Gown online orders will be April 30, 2022. After May 1st, Cap and Gowns can only be purchased during the first Graduation Practice, cost \$68.50 cash.

Measurement for Graduation Cap and Gown

The ordering of your cap and gown for graduation will be taken by Herff Jones.

Prices for the class of 2022 - Caps and Gown will be \$ 48.50 payable to Herff Jones through their online website until December 31st. Price will increase to \$68.50 on January 1st.

Graduation Announcements and Fine Paper Products

The cost of announcements varies depending upon the item(s) you choose to purchase and the quantity. A deposit for your announcement order will need to be paid when you place your order. The amount of the required deposit will be given to you in the meeting with Herff Jones. If you pay by check, **MAKE THE CHECK PAYABLE TO HERFF JONES.**

GRADUATION-May 26

To graduate in 2022, you are **REQUIRED** to attend the two (2) rehearsals that will guide you through the Graduation Ceremony activities. One of these practices will be held at TCHS in the Auditorium, *along with gown pickup*, and the second practice will be held at TCHS Gymnasium for a full graduation rehearsal.

Graduates must arrive fully dressed in cap/gown by 7:00am

Required dress code for graduation

Dresses or skirts/blouses:

Do not let your dress show below the hem of your gown. Dresses, skirts, and blouses should be a darker solid color as bright or light colors show through the gown. If stockings are worn, they should be flesh colored.

Dress pants:

Dress pants must be black with a darker solid color dress shirt. You must wear black shoes with dark colored socks.

Shoes:

Dress shoes must be all black. Thong type shoes (any type of flip flop) and tennis shoes/sneakers are not allowed. This is a safety issue for your protection as you are going up and down the stairs of a stage and to protect to formality of the event.

PICKING UP YOUR CAP, GOWN, & TICKETS FOR GRADUATION

Your CAP and GOWN may be picked up during our first mandatory practice.

Before your cap and gown can be issued to you, all obligations...Dual Enrollment books, library fines, parking fines, athletics, activity money, and any other outstanding obligation with St. Lucie County Schools...must be cleared. Senior Fees must also be paid.

Please note the following;

If you have morning senior privileges, you are still required to make arrangements to be at the senior meetings.

Senior updates will be sent via Teams.

It is the responsibility of all seniors to check with the sponsors and to look on the school website for updates.

APPENDIX A

GPA based Honor Cord Requirements

Based on classes from 9th grade to the end of 1st Semester in 12th grade, students who qualify for an Academic Honor Cord will receive an invitation to participate in the Senior Awards Ceremony.

Graduating with High Honors – Gold

Students must have a 3.8 or higher Weighted Overall GPA

Cost of Cord- \$8.00 and purchased through senior sponsors- Ms. Ankiel & Mrs. Landry.

Graduating with Honors – Silver

Students must have a 3.0 – 3.799 Weighted Overall GPA

Cost of Cord- \$8.00 and purchased through senior sponsors- Ms. Ankiel & Mrs. Landry.

Graduating with AA Degree- Gold, Black, Royal Blue

Cost of Cord- \$10 and purchased through Director of School Counseling- Ms. Korta.

Graduating with AICE Diploma- TCHS AICE Stole

Must be an AICE Diploma Recipient. AICE Diploma Candidates will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis- Stole provided by AICE Dept. – Mr. Wile

Nationally Recognized Honor Societies

Students must meet the specific requirements for the Honor Society and be recommended by the Honor Society Teacher Sponsor

French Honor Society – Red, White, & Blue- Mrs. Spranza

- **Academic requirements**
 - GPA (A- in French and B+ overall) Current enrollment in a level 2, 3, or AICE language/AICE literature French course
- **Membership requirements**
 - The student must attend bi-monthly meetings.
 - The student must complete the required number of volunteer hours.
- Cost of Cord- \$10.00

National Honor Society – Blue & Yellow- Mrs. Soran

- **Academic requirements**
 - 4.0 & above Weighted GPA
- **Membership requirements**
 - The student must complete required service hours and group volunteer efforts.

- The student must display outstanding character, service to the community, and have meaningful leadership experience.
- Must attend Honor Society meetings.

- Cost of Cord- \$8.00

Spanish Honor Society – Maroon & Gold- Mrs. Garcia

- **Academic requirements**
 - 3.0 & above Weighted GPA
- **Membership requirements**
 - The student must complete the 50 required volunteer hours.
 - The students must have at least 70% attendance record for meetings.
- Cost of Cord- \$8.00

Academy Honor Cords:

- Students must have at least a 3.0 weighted overall GPA
- Have completed at least 3 sequential courses in that academy content area
 - (Ex. Level 1, 2, & 3 or Level 1, 2, & AICE, or Level 2, 3, 4)
 - Have an average GPA of 3.0 weighted in those three academy content courses
 - **AND** meet any additional requirements listed below:
